

Proposed Bylaw changes first reading: 4/5/2018

These will be New Adds to the Bylaws.

Article IX. Use of Club Facilities and Property

Section 3.

New Pistol Range behind club house and the indoor pistol range cannot be used when there is a meeting or club function being held in the meeting room.

Section 4.

When there is a designated youth event (example, youth archery, Boy/Girl Scouts, 4H and fishing derby) consisting of ages 16 years old or younger, no indoor or outdoor ranges are permitted to be used by members with the exception of the Indoor Archery and the Trap Range use on Friday nights. The scheduled event can use the ranges needed for their event.

Section 5.

Any damage done, accidentally or intentionally, must be reported to a club officer immediately.

Article VIII. Range Rules – Safety.

Section 7.

When using the indoor pistol range, no one is permitted to shoot any closer than behind the designated shooting benches in the back of the range, unless it is being done as a sanctioned club event.

Article III. Duties of Officers.

Section 9.

Anyone caught damaging club property intentionally will be brought before the Club Board. The Board will decide if the offender would be suspended, expelled from the club or have the authorities involved for an investigation. Anyone that accidentally damages the club property and did not come forward admitting the damage, will be brought before the Club Board, and the Board will decide if any action is needed.
